For next term our PE days will be changing. Below are the PE slots until February half term; we are now delivering our PE slots in 6 week blocks so there will be a further change to PE days after half term. For these days your child/ren will need to have a full PE kit, in a bag, in school – black shorts/trackie bottoms/running tights (not leggings), black school PE T-shirt, jumper – preferably a school hoody and trainers. The weather will start to become chillier – PE still happens outdoors – trackies and a hoody are essential. There are some girls in Dragonfly who are not bringing in a change of bottoms for PE – please can you make sure that your child has a full PE kit in school on their PE days.

As always if you are sending your child into school with PE trainers with laces they are expected to be able to tie their shoe laces. If your child struggles with this, can I please politely ask that you invest time over the holidays to teach your child how to tie their laces – it is really not our job to do it and untied laces are just an accident waiting to happen. Very reasonably priced children's trainers with Velcro fastenings can be purchased from Tesco if your child is finding tying shoe laces challenging.

<u>Lunchtimes and Playtime Snacks - New Year, New Start</u>

It has come to my attention that quite a few children are not bringing a snack to school at playtime but are choosing to eat something out of their lunch box instead. This week some of our year 5/6 children have completed a litter pick and the amount of litter that was found on the school field and playground was simply quite astounding – yoghurt tubes, peperami wrappers, mini cookie wrappers, fruit winder wrappers, cereal bar wrappers, sausage roll packaging, cheese string wrappers etc. Four carrier bags full.

The decision has been made that for January, break times will be a wrapper free snack time. Children can bring snacks from home in named tubs without any packaging in order to maintain a litter free playground.

Acceptable playtime snacks will be:

- Cheese
- · Slices of meat
- Small pita bread with something like humous
- Bread sticks, malt loaf,
- Ríce cakes
- · Hard-boiled egg
- Banana, apple, satsuma/orange; any fruit (please cut up grapes)
- Raísíns
- Carrot sticks, cucumber (any raw vegetables)
- Tomatoes
- Home-made items such as low sugar flapjacks or oatmeal bars with dried fruit are also encouraged

Please do not send in any processed/packaged high sugar/high fat goods and no peanut or nut foods due to allergies. Please do not send in crisps, biscuits, chocolate bars, sweets or sugared cereal bars. Children will be asked to put these away and offered a piece of fruit from school instead. This information will be discussed with the children on the first assembly back in the new year.

There were also a large selection of wrappers such as Haribo packets and lollipop wrappers which are probably a result of sweets brought in for someone's birthday and then discarded on the floor. If this continues, then we will also consider not allowing these birthday treats to be given out. Your support with this is very much appreciated.
